North Central District Health Department (NCDHD) has been made aware of 531 new COVID-19 cases in the district since last reporting period on 1/18/2022.

NCDHD is offering scheduled COVID-19 Testing through TotalWellness beginning Friday, January 28th. PCR and Rapid tests are available. This testing is offered in O'Neill and is BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. Get FREE at-home Rapid Antigen COVID-19 tests! Visit covidtests.gov to order yours. Every home in the U.S. is eligible to order 4 free at-home COVID-19 tests. The tests are completely free-there is no shipping cost and you do not need to enter a credit card number. Orders will usually ship in 7-12 days.
