NCDHD COVID-19 Updates Public Service Announcement

North Central District Health Department (NCDHD) has been made aware of 58 additional cases across the district: 8- Pierce, 14-Knox, 20-Holt, 4-Boyd, 7- Antelope, 3-Brown, 1-Keya Paha, 1-Cherry.

A reminder that TestNe will be in O'Neill tomorrow morning, Tuesday, October 13th from 8:30 AM – 10:30 AM. Enter the drive through clinic through the East ally entrance behind the NCDHD building and remain in your car.

NCDHD will be hosting the following upcoming drive-through public influenza vaccine clinics throughout the district. Please note a time update to the Springview clinic.

- Thursday, October 15th – 7:30 AM – 9: 30 AM – O'Neill – access clinic through East alley entrance
- Thursday, October 15th – 2 PM – 3:15 PM, 3:45 PM-7 PM – Atkinson – West Holt School
- Thursday, October 15th – 2 PM – 6 PM – Orchard- Fire Hall

To fast track the clinic process, complete the vaccination form online prior to arrival and have a copy of your insurance card with you. If unable to complete vaccination form prior to the clinic NCDHD will have hard copies available and will be making copies of insurance cards as needed.
