Mercury Thermometer Collection Targeted for Brown County Health Fair

North Central District Health Department will be collecting mercury thermometers in exchange for digital thermometers at the **Brown County Health Fair** on Wednesday, September 22, 2004.

Metallic mercury is a silvery, mobile, liquid that is used in thermometers. It is a hazardous chemical that can cause harmful health effects when inhaled. In fact, most toxic effects relating to mercury exposure are from breathing contaminated air.

Prevention and source reduction of metallic mercury is the key to a healthy environment. To reduce the risk of mercury exposure, avoid using products that contain metallic mercury, and use substitutes such as digital thermometers which are available.

Bring your mercury thermometer by the *North Central District Health Department's* booth between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. at the Ainsworth Community Center, to exchange your old mercury thermometer for a new digital thermometer while supplies last.
