Public Service Announcement

North Central District Health Department (NCDHD) has been made aware of 4 new COVID-19 cases in the district since last reporting period on 3/14/2022.

NCDHD is offering scheduled COVID-19 Testing through TotalWellness on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. PCR and Rapid tests are available. This testing is offered in O’Neill and is BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. This testing can be utilized by symptomatic/exposed individuals or for those in need of a COVID-19 test for travel. Any individual with immunocompromising conditions is eligible for a COVID-19 booster dose 3 months after their 3rd dose. If you have questions about your eligibility or when you should get your booster dose, please contact your medical provider or NCDHD at 402-336-2406.
