Emergency Response



Since the last Board of Health meeting, Danielle has continued to support a variety of public health preparedness and outreach initiatives across the district.

She has successfully taught several CPR classes throughout the district as part of NCDHD's summer initiative to improve emergency response capacity and community readiness. These classes have been well-received and continue to generate interest among community members and partner organizations.

Danielle remains actively involved in regional preparedness efforts, attending local PET (Planning, Exercise, and Training), LEPC (Local Emergency Planning Committee), and NACCHO-sponsored PPOM (Preparedness Planning, Outcomes and Measures) meetings to strengthen collaboration and consistency across jurisdictions.

Progress continues on finalizing Emergency Response Plans, Points of Dispensing (POD) plans, and Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with local healthcare facilities and other partners. Danielle is working closely with RROMRS (Rural Region One Medical Response System) to ensure all hospital partners remain engaged and informed of available resources and services. She is also in the process of updating all Emergency Response Plans for submission to the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services as part of ongoing compliance and quality improvement.

As part of NCDHD's community outreach, Danielle represented the agency at the Ranch Expo in Bassett and the Healthcare Conference in O'Neill, where she distributed public health materials and provided information on emergency preparedness, disease prevention, and available programs.

Community Impact Coordinator

Culturally Grounded Diabetes Prevention Efforts

A recent visit to Nebraska Indian Community College facilitated the initiation of connections focused on culturally grounded diabetes prevention. A presentation on Indigenous healing underscored the significance of traditional foods and cultural identity in promoting health. Personal experiences shared during the session highlighted both the potential benefits and challenges of encouraging traditional practices, particularly in communities experiencing fatigue from conventional diabetes messaging. Discussions with college staff involved in nutrition, farming, outreach, and media revealed a well-established foundation of local wellness initiatives. This visit reinforced the critical need for culturally relevant health approaches.

Website Resource Updates

The website has been enhanced with the addition of two new resources: a Physical Activity Guide and a Measles Resource Page. These pages are intended to support community members by providing ideas for maintaining healthy, active lifestyles and by offering reliable, up-to-date information on measles prevention and response.

Media Display Relocation and Expansion

The Reach media display was relocated from the Red and White in Ainsworth to the Ainsworth senior center after the former was no longer able to host it. This relocation ensures continued community access to important health messaging. Additionally, a new media display was successfully installed at the Bloomfield pharmacy, further expanding outreach efforts by delivering health information in a trusted, high-traffic setting.

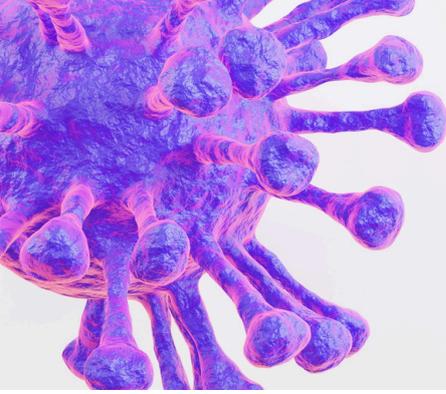
Increasing Resource Engagement

Ongoing collaboration with the Wausau Clinic aims to identify effective strategies to enhance individuals' willingness to engage with available community resources. Current discussions focus on overcoming barriers by developing approaches that are accessible and relevant to the local population. Efforts are also underway to adapt and implement the mental health component of the initiative to address unique challenges in rural settings, such as limited provider availability, stigma, and geographic isolation.

Completed one class in May/June with one participant, we have 2 classes that are scheduled continuously in O'Neill, we just move the start date until we have participants. Disease Surveillance



Measles

- Worked with schools on required vaccination reporting for incoming Kindergarten and 7th graders.
- While no confirmed cases within the state, active monitoring continues in coordination with state partners.
- Readiness checklists and action plans were created for rapid response and shared with clinics and hospitals.
- Measles cases continue to rise nationally with many states declaring outbreaks.

Enteric Illness/Animal Exposure

- Continued notable seasonal rise correlating with warming temperatures, increased outdoor activities and animal exposures.
- Prevention messaging is being reinforced, particularly around handwashing and food safety.
- Labs are being monitored for tickborne diseases

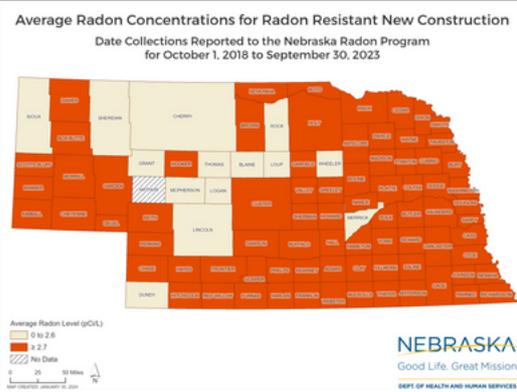

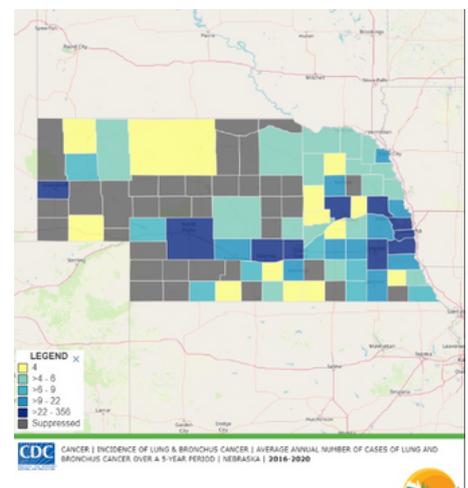
NCDHD continues to encourage Radon Test Kit sales. Radon education and kits sales are available in office, online and community outreach such as the farm and home shows.

HQUIP (Healthcare Quality Improvements Platform) continues to have monthly check in meetings on what can be done to improve the amount of Lung Cancer screening in each CAH and how it can be promoted. NCDHD has reached out to HQUIP and advised them that we will be moving to quarterly virtual meeting starting in October but will still be receiving monthly data counts of lung cancer screening in each hospital via emails.

Though our more recent meeting on July 17 it was discussed that Avera and NCDHD with the help from NALHD, have created a JACHT video focusing on Public Health and the importance Lung Cancer Screening. HQUIP has offered to help promote it to The Executive Director of The Nebraska Rural Health Association, The Director of The Nebraska Hospital Association and Various CEO's of the CAHs within our Learning Network.



The map compares the average pre-mitigation radon levels in Nebraska counties by using data from October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2023. Note that homes with elevated radon levels were found in all counties that had testing results. Regardless of geographic location, all homes should be tested for radon.

West Nile



Amy attended the Ranch Expo in June and distributed mosquito wipes and tick education to the many people that visited the NCDHD booth.

NCDHD will make efforts in the area to educate the public on the importance of taking proper precautions to protect themselves.

Distribution of mosquito repellent wipes and dunks to city clerks and golf courses, have been completed to 11 city offices and 7 golf courses in the district.

NCDHD completed flagging for ticks at Niobrara SP and Grove Lake WMA in June.

PSA's will be sent to local radio and newspaper outlets to notify the public of the positive WNV mosquito pools.

This is due to the staggered mosquito sampling schedule where half of participating counties sample one week and the remaining half sample the following week. Therefore, it takes a full two weeks of sampling to survey all participating counties across the state.

^The vector index is calculated based on *Culex pipiens/pallnarius/restuans* and *Culex tarsalis* mosquito species caught in CDC light traps. Mosquito pool testing and mosquito abundance data from the two most recent CDC weeks is used to determine the vector index for the reported CDC week. 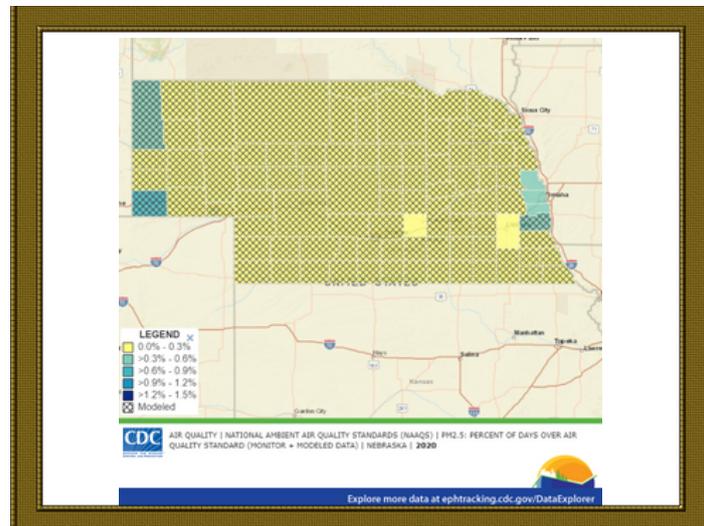
Environmental Health

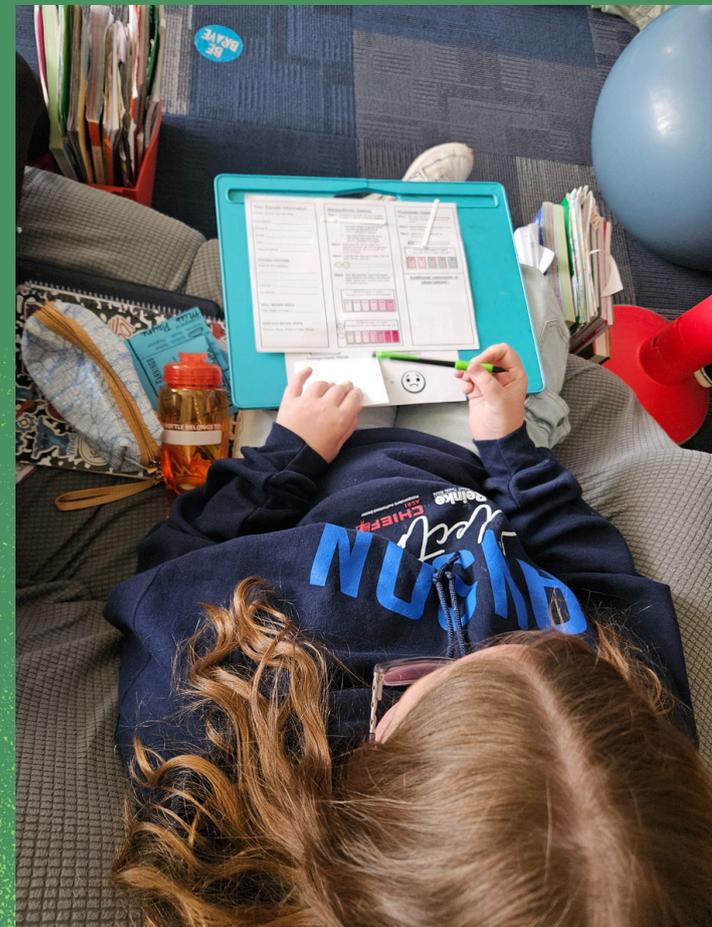
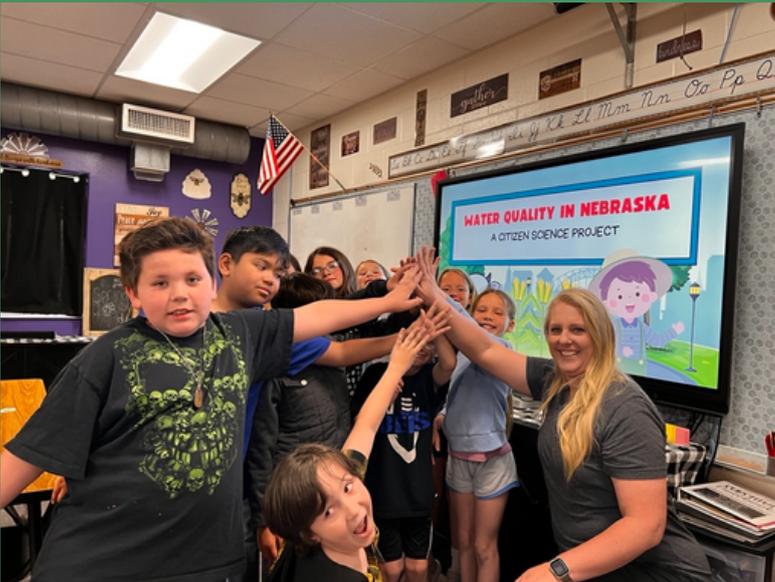

The Citizen Science Project has been completed for the 24-25 school year. NCDHD was able to have participation from 23 schools. 441 students, teachers and faculty engaged in the project, asking questions and learning the health effects of high nitrate levels in Nebraska.

All results are collected and entered in the SuWell Water Quality Database at the University of Nebraska Lincoln.

Lead



What is Lead?

Lead is a naturally occurring element found in small amounts in the earth's crust. While it has some beneficial uses, it can be toxic to humans and animals, causing health effects.

Where is Lead Found?

Lead can be found in all parts of our environment – the air, the soil, the water, and even inside our homes. Much of our exposure comes from human activities including the use of fossil fuels including past use of leaded gasoline, some types of industrial facilities and past use of lead-based paint in homes. Lead and lead compounds have been used in a wide variety of products found in and around our homes, including paint, ceramics, pipes and plumbing materials, solders, gasoline, batteries, ammunition and cosmetics.

Lead may enter the environment from these past and current uses. Lead can also be emitted into the environment from industrial sources and contaminated sites, such as former lead smelters. While natural levels of lead in soil range between 50 and 400 parts per million, mining, smelting and refining activities have resulted in substantial increases in lead levels in the environment, especially near mining and smelting sites.

When lead is released to the air from industrial sources or spark-ignition engine aircraft, it may travel long distances before settling to the ground, where it usually sticks to soil particles. Lead may move from soil into ground water depending on the type of lead compound and the characteristics of the soil.

Federal and state regulatory standards have helped to reduce the amount of lead in air, drinking water, soil, consumer products, food, and occupational settings.



Flyers are now distributed at the three OB departments at the Cherry County Hospital, Antelope Memorial and Avera St Anthony's Hospitals. Key components including why it matters, common sources of lead, the right way to clean and things to avoid during pregnancy. These flyers will be given to expecting parents at their pre-natal evaluation.

Procedure: Production Bonus

Scope: All Eligible, Full-Time Employees

PROCEDURE:

A production bonus may be provided to employees to assist in the personal costs of out-of-pocket premium expenses for individual, couple, or family health insurance.

Effective 1/1/2026, bi-weekly Production Bonus stipend to supplement out of pocket premium (up to):

Employee	\$135 \$145
Employee & Spouse	\$180 \$195
Employee & Family	\$245 \$265

Documentation of coverage and/or premium payments for health insurance/health coverage are required to receive the stipend. Production Bonus Health Insurance Stipend Authorization Form should be completed with proof of premium/coverage documentation.

Employees are responsible for notifying the NCDHD Health Director if status for eligibility changes. This includes a change in out-of-pocket costs for premium rates, loss of coverage, eligibility for a different tier of the stipend structure, etc.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible, employees must be full time, must pay out of pocket for health insurance, and must provide documentation of coverage. Employees not paying out of pocket premium rates are not eligible.

Production Bonus Health Insurance Stipend Authorization Form

A production bonus may be provided to employees to assist in the personal costs of out-of-pocket premium expenses for individual, couple or family health insurance or catastrophic health coverage costs per the Production Bonus procedure.

I understand in order to qualify for the bi-weekly health insurance stipend I must provide proof of premiums paid and/or current health insurance coverage. Proof of coverage could consist of providing documentation of premiums paid or current health insurance cards. I will also be responsible for notifying NCDHD Executive Administration if my stipend amount should change or if I no longer qualify for this benefit per the Production Bonus procedure.

I qualify for and elect to take the following Health Insurance Stipend (effective 1/1/2026):

- Employee Only Coverage: ~~\$135~~ \$145/pay period
- Employee + Spouse Coverage: ~~\$180~~ \$195/pay period
- Employee + Family Coverage: ~~\$245~~ \$265/pay period

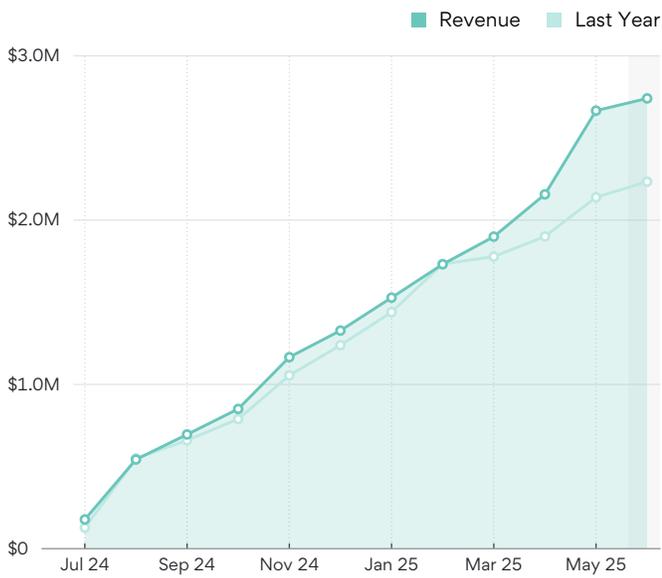

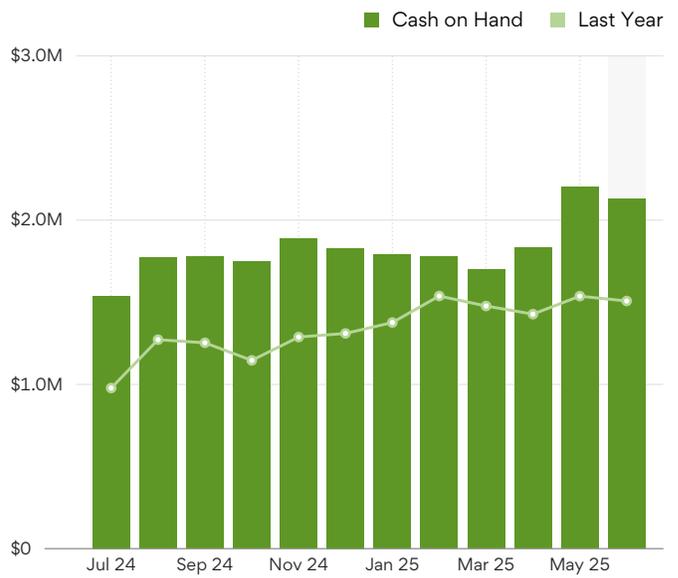

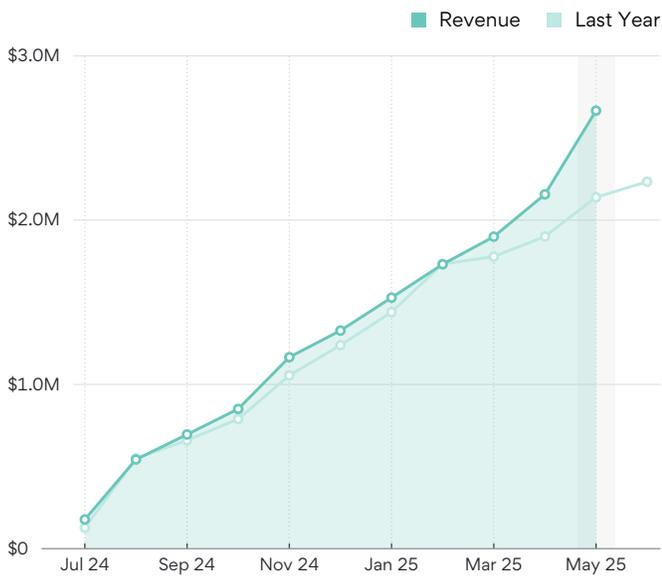

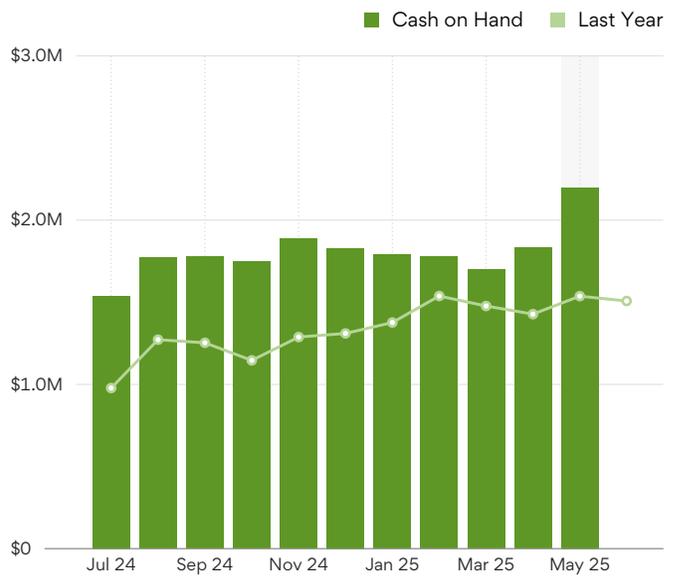

Board Designated Reserve

 - a. The target reserve amount was discussed, with a recommended minimum of three months of operating expenses (\$417,688.00), based on projections from the FY 2024–2025 budget. The Board of Health is requested to discuss and provide strategic direction on next steps, including comparisons to practices from other departments.

- b. Further discussion included consideration of a six-month reserve (\$835,376.00) and the implications of setting that as a long-term goal. Sam emphasized the current fiscal environment and the importance of board engagement given potential volatility.
- c. Policy and procedure updates were proposed to include a requirement for majority board agreement—via email, regular, or special meetings—with formal approval to be recorded at the next scheduled board meeting when funds are to be accessed.

2. If applicable, presentation of Board Designated Reserve target minimum
 - a. *Motion #5 by Dennis Bauer and seconded by Jean Henes to approve establishment of board designated reserve for 6 months of \$835,376.16. All in favor; Motion carried.*

Fee Schedule

1. Pricing of new fee for service-CPR courses:

Pricing for the newly launched in-house CPR courses was reviewed. A standard fee schedule has been established, and funding is currently available to support initial implementation. Summer promotional rates are planned to help generate interest and build momentum for the program's rollout.

2025-2026 COVID-19 seasonal pre-order

1. Presentation of pre-order options: Pre-order timelines, potential benefit changes with insurance coverage, and associated risks were presented for discussion. Pre-ordering ensure timely shipment ahead of our busy fall vaccination season. The BOH reviewed considerations related to vaccine returns and reimbursement, inventory, and allocation for VFC and VFA programs.
 - a. *Motion #7 by Lon Knievel and seconded by Jean Henes to pre-order 400 doses of vaccine. All in favor; Motion Carried.*

FY25 Audits

1. Review Annual and Single Audit Proposal

 - a. The Board of Health provided feedback on prioritizing core services and strategic direction for pursuing private funding or grant opportunities. The discussion included a review of roles and responsibilities defined by state statutes and the broader mission of

the Health Department. One board member suggested exploring the integration of a physical activity and nutrition program targeting elementary students, with a focus on aligning efforts with existing school-based initiatives.

2. Staff and Admin top programs of impact/prioritization matrix
 - a. Key public health services were reviewed, with an explanation of their value and the efforts involved in program delivery. Several board members identified specific areas of concern they believe are of high importance. The Executive Director provided clarification on which services are currently supported through dedicated grant or fiscal funding. An overview was also given of services being scaled back due to funding constraints and the resulting impact on local efforts.

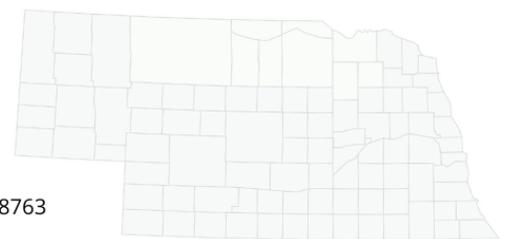
