NCDHD COVID-19 Updates Public Service Announcement

North Central District Health Department (NCDHD) has been made aware of 1 new COVID-19 cases in the district since last reporting period on 5/20/2021: 0-Antelope, 0-Boyd, 0-Brown, 0-Cherry, 1-Holt, 0- Keya Paha, 0-Knox, 0-Pierce, 0-Rock. NCDHD encourages district residents to continue to wear your mask in public places or where social distancing is difficult as well as practice social distancing while out in public.

Test Nebraska Clinics will be in O'Neill on Mondays from 8:30 AM -10:30 AM at NCDHD. Access to the clinic will be through the alley on the North side of the NCDHD building. Please note this location change. To sign up for a testing time visit testnebraska.com.

Update on COVID Vaccine in the NCDHD District:

- Fully vaccinated= 14,600
- Partially vaccinated= 379
- Total doses administered= 29,578
- Fully vaccinated that is 16+= 40.6%

The office of Governor Pete Ricketts held their final COVID response update/ press briefing today. It was announced today during the briefing that the current DHM will terminate at 11:59 pm on May 24, 2021. NCDHD along with other local health departments will continue with case investigating and quarantine and isolation recommendations for COVID-19 along with other communicable diseases as outlined by the CDC.

Case count update as of 5/24/2021 at 3:00 PM: 4,508 Total Cases (TC), 4,398 (R), 74 Deaths (D), and 10 total cases reported in the last 14 days. A reminder that Total Case (TC) numbers are represented first, and of those total cases the number of Recovered (R) persons is represented second, and total case related Deaths (D) is represented third.
