## “Positive Case in Knox County and Test Nebraska in the NCDHD District This Month” Public Service Announcement

North Central District Health Department (NCDHD) has been made aware of an additional positive case in Knox County. Through contact investigations the case is deemed to be from community spread. Residents of Knox County should assume the illness is in their community, as community spread is present in the county.

NCDHD would like to remind residents that Test Nebraska will be holding additional testing events in the district through the rest of the month. The next testing events will be June 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> 8 am-12 pm in O'Neill at the Holt County Roads Department. Clinics will also take place at the Valentine Fire Hall June 21<sup>st</sup> from 10 am – 2 pm and June 22<sup>nd</sup> from 8 am – 12 pm. Residents can sign up online at [www.testnebraska.com](http://www.testnebraska.com) one week prior to the testing event. To sign up for a Test Nebraska event please visit the Test Nebraska website. The questionnaire is available in English or Spanish. Click the START NOW button at the top to begin and complete the questions to the best of your knowledge. Based on the answers given, it will be determined if you qualify to be tested. If you qualify, you will need to schedule your test. Directions to the clinic site will be available based on the clinic you select. Please save or print the QR code that is generated after scheduling and bring this with you to the clinic.
