### **Public Service Announcement**

North Central District Health Department (NCDHD) has been made aware of 11 new COVID-19 cases in the district since last reporting period on 7/19/2021: Boyd-1, Antelope-3, Brown-2, Holt-5. New recoveries throughout the district will be reported out in next week's press release.
